AAACN Group Membership Program Details

AAACN will offer a discounted membership rate per the chart below **for a minimum of 25 members** who join AAACN and whose annual dues are paid by their employer. Your organization will be asked to collect and return the minimum number of applications in one group along with **one** payment at the discounted rate.

<u>Adding NEW members</u>: Upon hiring new staff, your organization can provide new hires with a membership application and return the form to the appropriate individual at your facility to be submitted with your corporate payment to AAACN. Memberships are not transferable from one person to another.

Renewals: Administration of this program is easy! AAACN will send one renewal invoice to your facility annually. The invoice will contain a complete list of current members. Your facility will be asked to confirm current employment and continuation of membership for each of your nurses listed. You may also add any new hires at this time. Your facility will be asked to remit one payment to AAACN for the total number of membership renewals. If your group membership total drops below your original percentage tier, the next appropriate tier will apply to all new members. At renewal time, the total number of enrolled members will determine the renewal rate for the program. When enrollment drops below the lowest tier, the normal dues will apply.

Nurses who join in the middle of the calendar year will be processed at a lower dues rate to keep everyone on the same renewal cycle so that your facility will only be invoiced once per year for renewing members. (Example: A nurse joins in May. Your facility will be asked to pay 8 month's dues for this nurse instead of a full year. This will place the nurse on the December 31 renewal cycle, along with the rest of your nurses. With the December 31 renewal invoice, you then pay this nurse's dues for a full year thereafter.) A chart showing pro-rated renewal fees will be provided to you if requested.
