



NURSE SENSITIVE INDICATORS (NSI)

NSIs ASSESS, EVALUATE, AND ARTICULATE THE VALUE OF AMBULATORY CARE NURSING .

WHY NSIs

- Standardizes measurements of care and care processes
- Bases care on evidence
- Measures, evaluates, and improves nursing practice
- Measures elements of patient care and patient outcomes directly affected by nursing practice
- Improves processes and communication across levels of care
- Provides the ability to benchmark across organizations

PROCESS

- Surgical/Procedural Errors (Wrong Site, Wrong Patient, Wrong Procedure, Wrong Implant)
- Patient Falls
- Patient Burns
- Unplanned Postoperative Admission
