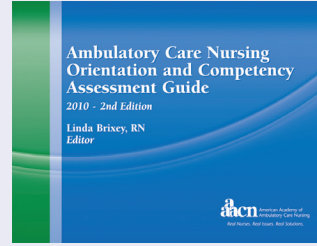

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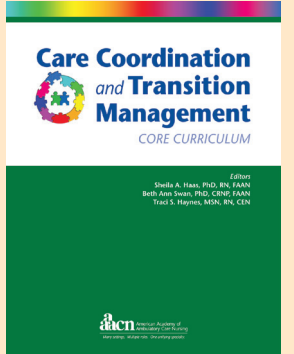

Care Coordination and Transition Management (CCTM) Core Curriculum text, 2014

The *CCTM Core* text covers 13 dimensions, competencies, and activities. There is an introduction chapter dedicated to the transition from acute care to ambulatory care and the critical nature of hand-offs in ensuring patient safety and quality of care. Two chapters are devoted to technologies that provide decision support and information systems for all dimensions of care coordination and transition management: one focused on informatics and one focused on telehealth nursing practice. The text is evidence-based and is organized to include definitions, learning outcomes and objectives, a table of knowledge, skills, and attitudes (KSAs), and nationally recognized core competencies for quality and safety education for nurses (QSEN), inter-professional collaborative practice, and public health nursing competencies. The text is written for nurses in all settings; from ambulatory care to hospitals, extended care facilities to student nurses. 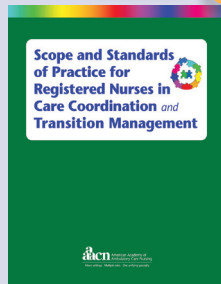

Scope and Standards of Practice for Registered Nurses in Care Coordination and Transition Management, 2015

While these roles have been evolving over the past 25 years, there has never been formal identification, specification and/or publication of the scope and standards of practice. This publication will set the standard for excellence in the coordination of care and is written as a resource for both acute and ambulatory care nurses. The *Standards* address both the clinical dimension and the management dimension of CCTM, and may be used as a tool to advance professional care coordination and/or transition management nursing practice, patient and population health, and the performance outcomes of health care institutions.

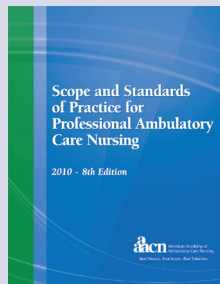


Scope and Standards of Practice for Professional Ambulatory Care Nursing, 8th Edition, 2010

The 8th edition explicitly identifies and defines ambulatory nursing practice in outpatient settings. The first formal Scope of Practice statement contains a definition of ambulatory care practice, an expanded conceptual framework, the characteristics of the practice, the roles of professional ambulatory care nurses, and the trends and issues in ambulatory care settings and nursing practice.

The *Standards* have been re-categorized into two major classifications: the nursing process and professional performance standards. Each standard contains distinct measurement criteria to clarify the domains of practice of clinical and administrative practice. Use this resource to guide nursing competencies, improve or create policies, procedures and standards, train and orient staff, create clinical, telehealth and administrative job descriptions, and plan for regulatory agency surveys. The *Standards* will also assist registered nurses in preparing for the ANCC ambulatory care nursing certification examination.

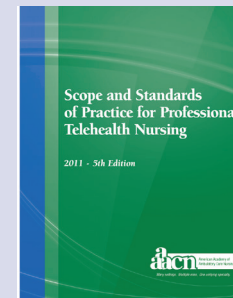


Scope and Standards of Practice for Professional Telehealth Nursing, 5th Edition, 2011

The 5th edition provides scope and practice guidance specific to the ambulatory subspecialty of telehealth. The *Standards* promote effective clinical and administrative management of the increasingly complex telehealth nursing roles and responsibilities in a changing health care environment. Sixteen standards are included along with competencies for telehealth registered nurses, nurse executives, administrators, and managers. The *Standards* reflect current professional norms, practices, and expectations.

The publication can be used to advance ambulatory care professional nursing practice, patient health, and the performance outcomes of telehealth institutions. This resource is ideal for writing policies, procedures, and job descriptions; orienting staff; planning for Joint Commission surveys; and increasing the quality and safety of patient care. You can also use the *Standards* to prepare for the ANCC ambulatory care nursing certification exam, which contains questions on telehealth nursing and is the recommended exam to validate telehealth nursing knowledge.
